Welcome Newly Elected Board Members

At our annual meeting in November, Deb Beck, Diane Schoch and Tom Wagner assumed their duties as board members. We extend a warm welcome to them.

A Message from the Board President:

Merrick Foundation is proud to continue the support of the non-profits that serve in all parts of our county. We provide support and services to many segments of the population, regardless of age and interests. Our fifteen board members represent each of the communities that we serve, and they strive to meet the needs of all county residents. Without our capable staff, much of what we achieve would not be possible. Kudos to Chuck Griffith-Executive Director, Courtney Retzlaff-Chief Financial Officer, Andrea Green- Communications/Publications and Anita Kucera-Education and Public Outreach.

We have achieved considerable growth in total assets. As of January 31st, 2018 we attained a new high of slightly above \$18 million. Donations in 2017 totaled \$407,577. Our total growth does come with a caveat, as bull markets of the past year(s) have helped achieve this total and this trend may not continue. However, taking advantage of this growth, we have been able to fund large grants to Merrick County Child Development Center (\$150,000), Merrick Medical Center (\$150,000) and established long term support of \$100,000 for the new proposed museum.

Additionally, and just as importantly, our scholarship committee has completed this year's scholarship awards. This committee spends many hours poring through the applications we receive. 105 college scholarships totaling \$84,400 and 88 high school scholarships totaling \$69,000 were awarded this year. Congratulations to all the recipients, and special thanks to the committee members and our staff for their time and effort.

We continue to support the Merrick County Youth Council. The modular building purchased last year has been approved for occupancy. A 30' x 30' deck has been added and work is now progressing on the metal building adjacent to this site. We promote the Dark Island Trail, support many community activities and organizations and continue to look toward new opportunities where we may be of assistance.

My challenge to each of you is to support our efforts with your donations of time and financial resources. Every donation counts, regardless of size. Consider setting up an Acorn Fund and contributing to it annually. Visit with your financial consultant, attorney or accountant about a bequest or living legacy to the Foundation. It takes everyone's commitment to the communities we serve in order for the Merrick Foundation to continue to meet its mission.

Grant Application Procedures

1. The Community Grant deadline has been moved from the first of the month to the 10th of each month (following Monday if the 10th is on a weekend). Merrick Foundation meets on the 4th Monday of each month. No meeting is held in December. April's meeting is on the 4th Sunday in April (Scholarship Tea).
2. Grants are approved on the condition that grantees attend the Annual Meeting on the 4th Monday of November AND present a poster board (provided) display describing their grant.
3. Grant applications over \$10,000 may require representatives to attend a board meeting. They will be notified by the Grant Committee.
4. Grant requests over \$15,000 will be reviewed in January, June and October. Applicants shall be required to attend a board meeting.
5. Only one grant application form needs to be mailed to Merrick Foundation.
6. A separate (shorter) form is now available for student educational trips. It is listed separately on the Merrick Foundation web site. Schools are encouraged to apply as soon as possible for student trip funding. Grants for school trips are not to exceed the average class size in one year or twice the average class size in two years.

is a native of Fullerton and graduated from Fullerton High School. He received his BS in Business Administration with an emphasis in Ag-Business from Wayne State College. Jared






- Moving from talk to action




