

Patricia Campbell: A Historical Gift

hile 2020 was definitely a challenging year for many non-profits, the Central City Public Library received some pretty spectacular news. It began in January of 2020, with a phone call from Bernie Glaser.

Bernie had called both the Central City Public Library and the Merrick Foundation to talk about a bequest from his client, Patricia Campbell. "I received a call from Bernie in January. He let me know that Pat had recently passed away and had planned to leave a gift to the Library. He inquired about the Library's fund, its use, when it was set up and more specifics about how the Merrick Foundation was involved," states Shauna Graham, Executive Director at the Merrick Foundation.

It was mid-summer when they would hear from Bernie again, and the Central City Library would realize just how large this gift was going to be. They were told to

expect a gift of approximately \$1.5 million dollars.

"When we received the final distribution for the Library, the gifts totaled \$1,676,532.32," states Graham. "This is in addition to the \$100,000 that was given to the Merrick Foundation last summer in honor of her parents, Ina & Don Campbell. Pat's gift was the single largest gift in the history of the Merrick Foundation. She also left a gift equal in size to the Lincoln Public Schools Foundation. The intent of that donation is to help fund programs for high school aged students with disabilities."

"Miss Pat", as she was referred to by her friends, was born in Central City. Her parents, Don & Ina, owned farmland in both Merrick & Kimball counties. Though they lived in town, she had a horse named Queenie. She also loved watching movies in the theater her father managed.

She initially attended a private women's college in Illinois, but would graduate from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln with a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education. She taught at Central City Public Schools in her early teaching career before teaching in the Lincoln Public Schools system for 25 years. She retired in 1987.

One of her greatest loves was ballroom dancing, which she taught at the Arthur Murray studio as a young woman. For years she took joy in dancing and teaching the foxtrot, rumba, waltz and cha-cha. She even won a trip to New York to meet Arthur and Katherine Murray. In her later years, she would frequently visit the Playmore Ballroom just west of Lincoln and dance the hours away.

Board President Jeanne Grosshans is equally elated, "Words seem inadequate to express what an incredible gift the Central City Library has received from Pat Campbell. The money will strengthen the Library's ability to complete special projects that will enhance our mission, as well as enable our beautiful library to continue to offer outstanding services to the community."

"We feel honored and humbled to assist the Library with this fund, as well as being a part of carrying out Miss Pat's final wishes," states Graham. "This is truly a life changing gift for not only the Library, but our community."



Ed and his wife Laurie are referencing the "Acorn Fund" they started at the Merrick Foundation during Ed's time on the board of directors. Ed served on the board for 5 years, beginning in 2010. "Laurie & I have always made regular, monthly contributions to our Acorn Fund. It's easier to just have it taken directly out of our account, and have it go right where it needs to."

"Acorn Funds are a great way for individuals and families to start building a legacy at their hometown foundation," states Shauna Graham, Executive Director. "These types of funds allow donors to contribute over time, eventually building a permanent, endowed fund. Once the Acorn Fund reaches \$5,000, it can be invested and contributions then begin to multiply. The best part of building an endowed fund is that it will literally exist forever. Generation after generation, the causes you care about will receive support from the acorn you plant today."

Ed & Laurie, who both grew up in Merrick County and will soon celebrate their 37th wedding anniversary, feel that it's coming full circle. "The Foundation helped me when I was in high school, and our kids both got scholarships as well," states Dexter. "This has always been a place I want to give back to and we are proud to be able to do that. Starting a fund is one of the best things you can do for your community and for your county. Down the road it can help in so many areas. Just look at all that Merrick County has accomplished and will continue to accomplish."

"What started as the Dexter Acorn Fund is now two separate funds," states Graham. "One is a scholarship




fund for local high school and college students, and one will provide grants for local projects and non-profits. We feel honored to assist the Dexters in the areas they are passionate about. These funds will absolutely continue to benefit Merrick County for decades to come."






